Take Action on Radon



With the support of Health Canada, Take Action on Radon distributes 100 free radon test kits to approximately 30 municipalities annually across Canada to promote awareness of radon, an environmental carcinogen present in homes and buildings.

The 100 Radon Test Kit challenge is an initiative of Take Action on Radon which is a turn key program to work with municipalities to raise awareness on radon in the community and to distribute a limited number of free kits to community members. The program provides the free kits and all advertising resources but it does require a local community contact to help support the program with promotion within the community and organization distribution and collection of radon kits.
