We are excited to announce that applications are now open for the 2025 AMM Infrastructure Grant from the Western Financial Group Communities Foundation. We're offering up to five \$5,000 grants to support infrastructure projects in communities across Manitoba.

How to Apply:

AMM Infrastructure Grants are open to members of the Association of Manitoba Municipalities (AMM). Submit an online application for a current infrastructure project that:

- 1. Involves upgrading, enhancing, renovating, or constructing a **publicly owned asset**
- 2. Contributes to climate resilience, sustainability, accessibility or community health and safety
- 3. Only one application per municipality
- 4. Application Deadline: Midnight, November 3, 2025

The application takes approximately **15 minutes** to complete. Grant recipients will be notified by email in late-November.

Fish & Wildlife Enhancement Fund



The call to submit a Letter of Interest (LOI) for the Fish and Wildlife Enhancement Fund (FWEF) under the **Spring 2026 intake is now open**. Non-profits, community groups, and research institutions with ideas for fish and wildlife enhancement initiatives in Manitoba may submit a LOI as the first step in applying for a grant from FWEF. Applicants with eligible

projects at the LOI stage will be invited to submit a full application in the fall.

The deadline for Letter of Interest submission is 4:00 PM CST, September 15, 2025.

To be eligible to apply for a Fish and Wildlife Enhancement Fund grant for Spring 2026 you must submit your organization's LOI through our online <u>Granting Portal</u> prior to September 15, 2025. Late entries, and entries submitted through mail, will not be accepted.
