New Building Up Manitoba Program

On May 25, 2026, the Government of Canada and the Manitoba government announced the launch of the [Building Up Manitoba Program \(BUMP\)](#). This new workforce training program, funded through the Canada-Manitoba Labour Market Transfer Agreements, is designed to help small and medium-sized *employers invest in their workers, protect jobs, and boost productivity and competitiveness across the province.*

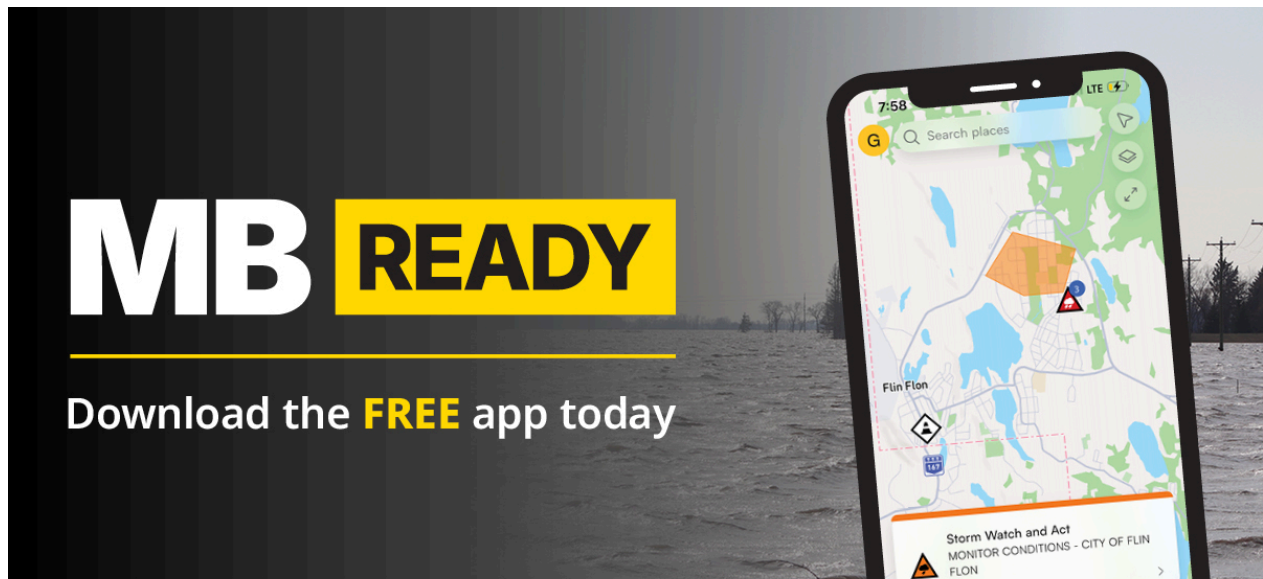
This is a new, streamlined program that adopts key criteria from the **Canada-Manitoba Job Grant** and the **Workforce Development Program** offering a single application process with two funding streams. Through BUMP, eligible small and medium-sized employers (those with less than 500 employees) can access up to \$100,000 in support *for employee training, upskilling, and the development of human resources and workforce development strategies.*

Eligible employers include:

- for-profit businesses, including corporations, sole proprietorships or partnerships
- non-profit organizations
- industry associations/sector councils
- Indigenous governments and health/education entities
- **municipal governments**
- unions

Applications are now being accepted, and you can visit the [website](#) for full program details. The program is following a continuous intake process until resources are exhausted.
