Decentralizing Food Waste in Manitoba: RM of Ritchot's FoodCycler Program



Food Cycle Science highlights the RM of Ritchot as one of the recent Manitoba municipalities to participate in the FoodCycler program, an innovative initiative aimed at tackling residential food waste. Using food recycling technology, households are empowered to manage their food waste right at the source of creation – in their own home.

100 homes in the community took part in the 12-week pilot last summer, diverting approximately 6.6 metric tonnes of food waste from their local landfill over that short span. On an annual basis, participating

households are expected to save over 4000 standard bags of garbage from the local landfill. For context, this is equivalent to diverting 34.4 metric tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub> (which is the same amount of carbon sequestered by 41.6 acres of forest!).

Ritchot is one of 25 Manitoba municipalities to participate in the FoodCycler program, and they are now exploring ways to build on this success and extend the program's impact across more homes. These strong waste diversion results have driven other communities to act on decentralizing food waste management, and your municipality could be next.
