Municipal Climate Internship Program



Environmental Leadership Canada is looking to recruit host municipalities for their Municipal Climate Internship program.

Municipal hosts are responsible for providing interns with:

- meaningful work related to environmental or climate priorities
- a supervisor to oversee their work and offer guidance
- opportunities to experience the municipal political process (e.g. attend council meetings)
- political mentorship in the form of a councillor or the mayor/warden assigned to the intern

ELC asks municipal hosts for a financial contribution of \$3,000 and to cover the WSIB or WCB costs for the intern (if needed). If the financial contribution is a barrier to participation, we are flexible and can discuss this on a case-by-case basis.

Applicants can apply by submitting an <u>expression of interest</u> by **Sept. 25, 2025**.

2 Billion Trees Program

The Province of Manitoba is excited to partner with the Government of Canada's 2 Billion Tree Program (2BT).

Urban tree planting efforts in municipalities and communities enhances tree cover and provides more shade (reducing summer cooling costs), captures storm runoff, and provides wind protection as well as air filtration.

As part of the 2BT program, we want to provide communities with free potted trees to plant on public properties. Those interested would be responsible to plant and water the trees once delivered to your community. Once the trees are planted, we will send out our staff to map the trees and share the points with Natural Resources Canada (NRCAN).

We have trees available this year for communities interested in planting.

A regulatory project to introduce "Ice Facility Plants" into the Power Engineer Regulation has introduced a new licence for Ice Facility Operators, while expanding the role of 5th class power engineers to act as shift engineers in Ice Facility Plants.
